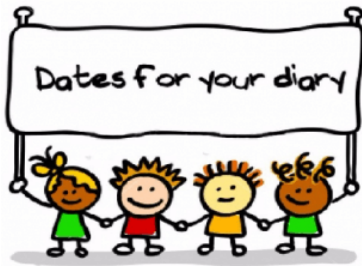

Last March, Cyclone Idai swept through Mozambique, Malawi, and Zimbabwe causing severe flooding and major loss of life. Tens of thousands of homes were destroyed and large areas of agricultural land were submerged destroying crops.

Give thanks that the Moderator's Appeal raised £242,155 for those affected and for all those who generously donated.
